Rules	The Competition is open to members and all children. All completed Entry Forms must be returned to Christine Jones at 32 Goodwell Lea or Village Hall Post Box , by 5.30 p.m. on Saturday, 10th April, 2010 . No late entries will be accepted . Each exhibit must be the property of the exhibitor and must be grown by them. Each exhibitor may enter only one item per class.								
Staging	This will take place between 8.15 p.m. and 8.45 p.m. on Tuesday, 13th April & 9.30 a.m. & 11.30 a.m. on Wednesday, 14th April . No exhibits will be accepted after this period. Exhibits must be prepared on the preparation table, under the general supervision of the show steward, placed partly covering the ticket showing the exhibitor's name and relevant class. Exhibitors will be provided with suitable containers for Classes 1 - 12 (& they cannot use their own) . For Classes 13 - 17 exhibitors may use their own containers. Exhibitors must provide their own containers for the remaining Classes, but the Club cannot be responsible for their safety.								
Identification	When staging, each exhibitor must obtain a card to be completed and placed with the entry (as directed by the steward).								
Judging	This will take place during Wednesday afternoon, when only the judge and steward will be present in the hall. Judges' decisions must be taken as final.								
Points	All classes are open to everybody. Trophies will be awarded on a points system. Trophies	Trophies will be awarded to the overall winner, the best exhibit, and the two children's categories. All awards to be held for one year.								

CLASSES

1. Vase of 3 large daffodils, same variety (trumpet as long or longer than the petals).
2. Vase of 3 large cupped 'narcissi' with one flower to the stem, same variety. (cup more than 1/3rd but less than the length of the petals).
3. Vase of 3 small cupped narcissi with one flower to the stem, same variety. (cup not more than 1/3rd the length of the petals).
4. Vase of 3 double daffodils/narcissi, one or more flowers to a stem.
5. Vase of 3 trumpet daffodils, mixed varieties.
6. Vase of 3 narcissi, mixed varieties.
7. Vase of mixed miniature daffodils/narcissi (not more than 10)
8. Vase of 5 muscari (grape hyacinths) same variety.
9. Vase of muscari (mixed varieties) up to 7 blooms.
10. Vase of 3 stems single dwarf tulips.
11. Vase of up to 7 mixed tulips which could include multi headed.
12. Vase of up to 7 tulips of the same variety which could be multi headed.
13. A bowl/pot planted with 3 outdoor hyacinths same variety.
14. Vase of mixed seasonal flowers (not exceeding 40 cms wide) **
15. Vase of mixed Spring blossom, (not exceeding 40 cms wide)
16. Vase of wild plant material including catkins (not exceeding 30 cms wide)
17. A bowl planted with mixed polyanthus, and primroses, (not exceeding 20 cms diam.) **

** Please note that these classes are also for children under 12 years, and between 12 and 16 years. (To be judged separately)

- Notes: a. Judging will be based primarily on conformance with class requirements and quality of entry
- b. Where "same variety" is specified, the judge will give credit for uniformity of specimens; and for "mixed" classes for the number of varieties.

Childrens Classes

18 (under 12) Vase of mixed seasonal flowers (not exceeding 40 cms x 30 cms.)

18 (under 16) Vase of mixed seasonal flowers (not exceeding 40 cms x 30 cms.)

19 (under 12) A bowl planted with mixed polyanthus, and primroses, (not exceeding 20 cms diam.)

19 (under 16) A bowl planted with mixed polyanthus, and primroses, (not exceeding 20 cms diam.)
